Chevron continues European aviation expansion

NEWCASTLE, UNITED KINGDOM – 23 August 2007 - Chevron Global Aviation has added a new refuelling location to its European operations at Newcastle airport in north east England. In addition, the firm has also secured its first fuel supply contract with the rapidly expanding, low fares air carrier, easyJet, at the airport.

The new location is the latest success in Chevron Global Aviation's UK and Ireland's regional development strategy that began some 10 years ago. Since then the firm has gained refuelling licenses at Manchester and East Midlands airports in the UK and Dublin and Shannon airports in Ireland.

Bringing the new airport location on stream took some time as it was back in 2004 that Newcastle Airport Authority decided to replace its existing fuel storage farm and into-plane with new facilities. In addition, it also offered for potential jet suppliers to sell at this location and Chevron was subsequently selected as one of the successful bidders.

"We're excited to provide our services at this rapidly growing location," said Gregor Cameron, General Manager for Chevron Global Aviation. "It was a long process to begin operations but we're pleased to have secured new customers here in a relatively short space of time."

Dave Batty, Negotiator, responsible for fuel in easyJet's Purchasing Department said, "easyJet are delighted that Chevron are now represented at Newcastle Airport and we're pleased to be working with them at this location."

Newcastle airport handles around five million passengers a year and demand is growing. It has one runway that serves more than 30 airlines flying to some 80 destinations worldwide. As well as the contract with easyJet – Newcastle’s largest customer – Chevron Global Aviation has also won contracts for Cyprus Airways, and with charter companies XL Airways and Flyjet at Newcastle.
